"With triumphant Joy you will drink deeply from the wells of salvation. In that glorious day, you will say to one another, 'Praise the LORD!' Give Thanks to the LORD! Tell your world about how mighty He is! Sing praises to the LORD, for He has done wonders!" (Isaiah 12:3-5)

Giving Thanks to the LORD should be on the lips of every Believer - every day! The Bible has so much to say about being thankful; here are 9 reasons you can give THANKS today:

- 1. GOD is deserving of your Thanks "Give THANKS to the LORD, for He is good: His Love endures forever!" (I Chronicles 16:34) (this verse is found throughout the Scriptures) You may think that GOD didn't have anything to do with where you are, but Paul states in I Corinthians 4:4, "What do you have that you did not receive [from GOD]"?
- 2. Thankfulness is a great witness "Give THANKS to the LORD, call on His Name; make known among the nations what He has done!" (I Chronicles 16:8) Telling your loved ones and neighbors what GOD has done in your life will open the door for Holy Spirit to work on them.
- 3. In the midst of your struggles and pain, Thank GOD; He is with you -"The LORD is my Strength and my Shield from every danger; when I fully trust Him, help is on the way! My heart leaps for Joy and I will give **THANKS to Him in song!** (Psalm 28:7) Your thanksgiving gives GOD the opportunity to do great things in your life and bring deliverance!

- 5. Giving Thanks is a COMMAND And JESUS took bread, gave Thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying "This is My body given for you; **DO THIS in remembrance of Me."** (Luke 22:19, I Corinthians 11:24)
- 6. Thanksgiving shows that you belong to GOD that builds character -"Give THANKS in all circumstances, for this is GOD's will for you in **Christ JESUS.**" (I Thessalonians 5:18) You belong to GOD! (I Cor. 3:23) "In You I live and move and have my being!" (Acts 17:28)
- 7. Give Thanks because GOD uses vessels like YOU to do His work -"THANKS be to GOD, Who always leads us in an endless triumph in Christ. He spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of GOD everywhere WE go!" (II Corinthians 2:14)
- 8. Give Thanks because you have a Savior and you needed saving -"Christ proved GOD's Love for us by dying in our place while we were sinners." (Romans 5:8) "Thanks be to GOD for His indescribable Gift!" (II Corinthians 9:15)
- 9. Give Thanks because you NOW live in Victory, "THANKS be to GOD, Who gives us the victory through our LORD JESUS Christ!" (I Cor. 15:57) "JESUS is for you Wisdom from GOD, Redemption, Righteousness and Sanctification!" (I Corinthians 1:30)





PILGRIMS OLD AND NEW GIVE THANKS!


I will build My Church, and the gates of hell shall not overpower it!" (Matthew 16:18)

If you ask me what Scripture I live by it is Romans 8:28: "GOD causes all things to work together for good to those who love GOD, to those who are called according to His purpose." I'm grateful for the upbringing I had as it helped me through a very serious situation in my life. I was in Austria, studying because I wanted to know more about my "roots". My father's parents emigrated from Austria to Canada in the early 1900's so I attended "Seminar Schloss Bogenhofen" and worked my way through school. I worked at a futon factory and although the end product results in fine pieces of furniture, the sawing and cutting produces sawdust.

The sawdust was deposited into a silo and then transferred to a furnace and used as fuel to heat the factory. One day in October, my boss asked me if I'd like some extra work and I jumped at the chance to earn a little more money and get out of class. The job was to empty the silo out back. My friend and I conceived the idea of stepping into the silo and pushing the sawdust out. We didn't realize that the sawdust was packed tightly and we had just opened up a small cavity at the bottom of the silo. I went into the opening and as my eves adjusted to the darkness. I realized that sawdust was falling down around me. Unable to move fast enough, I was engulfed with sawdust. Steve outside was surprised by how much sawdust I was pushing out, not realizing that the sawdust had completely filled the area we had cleared out, impacting me. Then he realized that I was in great danger and called for help.

Workers and the volunteer fire department personnel tried digging me out but couldn't find me in the tons of sawdust in the silo. I thought about digging my way to the top but I realized that I didn't have much oxygen so with my arms and hands in front of me, I tried to stay relaxed. I thought about how silly it was that I would die in a silo full of sawdust. And then I thought about GOD and that it was up to Him and that if He pulled me through, I'd serve Him forever.

Now, I wasn't the only one praying. They called a prayer meeting back at the college and even at the conference headquarters in Vienna. I sometimes feel as if I missed all the excitement since I was stuck in the dark while everyone back at school was called out of class to pray for "this college student who'd fallen into the silo." At first the rescue teams worked furiously, but then they figured, "What's the hurry; no one lasts long buried under 30 metric tons of sawdust!" I tried shouting but no one heard me. The thought crossed my mind that it would be a great irony if they were using pitchforks and found me by sticking me with one of them. Eventually I noticed that the sawdust was thinning out and I could see the sides of the silo! Someone on the catwalk on top of the silo shouted "Hello!" So I shouted "Hello" back. Then I heard a shout, "Er lebt nock!" (He's still alive!) I'm told that they cancelled the hearse and called the ambulance. I'd been in that silo for about 3 hours. I spent a night in the hospital for observation, but I was fine and was dismissed. GOD truly did work all things for my good that day so long ago and He continues to be with me today.



When you give to Home of Refuge, you aren't just feeding orphans, which in and of itself would be enough! You aren't just caring for once-homeless elderly, which in and of itself would be enough! You aren't just providing the Gospel of JESUS Christ to a community that has very little true knowledge of the Word of GOD, which in and of
